### Outdoor area / garden

• Low-barrier path with planed paving stones and passable, water-bound, covered paths in the outdoor area

# Museum building

- The building is accessible via a short ramp through an entrance without steps.
- The museum café is accessible.
- There is an accessible toilet.
- There are no collapsible wheelchairs or buggies for toddlers available.
- Assistance dogs are permitted in all areas.

#### **Exhibits**

- The exhibition spaces are suitable for wheelchair use.
- A gallery in the exhibition space can only be accessed with stairs.
- The Kunsthaus Dahlem is not equipped with a floor guidance system or a tactile floor plan.
- Texts in easy language (German) are available as a flyer for each exhibition.
- Basic information about the Kunsthaus Dahlem (history of the building, mission statement, how to find us) are available in easy language (German) at the website.

- Touch tours for the blind, the vision-impaired and sighted children and adults or inclusive tours with various sensory approaches to the exhibitions are offered regularly.
